All specimens must be the bona fide production of the exhibitor, except in the children's/junior floral art classes. Exhibitors whose entry fees total £7.00 or more (unless otherwise stated) will receive an Exhibitor's Pass to the Showground. ALL CARS MUST BE OFF THE SHOWGROUND BY 9.00am ON THE 12th JULY 2025

Prize money will be paid on Show Day by Chief Steward. SECURITY WILL BE ON PATROL OVER THE SHOW PERIOD.
