1	First Ridden	First Ridden. Riders 11 yrs and under. SPSBS Rosette to 1st placed
2	Lead Rein	Riders 9yrs and under. Lead rein to be attached to noseband of a snaffle bridle. SPSBS Rosette to 1st placed
3	Young Handler	Young Handler. 14 yrs and under. SPS-BS Rosette to 1st placed - Special rosette for under 8 yrsGEMS Rosette to the highest placed GEMS member wearing a 2026 GEMS badge.
4	Novice pony	Standard Novice Shetland Pony, any age or gender. Not to have been placed 1st up to date of entry closing date.
5	Standard Junior Gelding	Standard Gelding Three years and under. 1st and 2nd eligible for Gelding Championship
6	Standard Senior Gelding	Standard Shetland Pony Gelding. Four years and over. 1st and 2nd eligible for gelding Championship.
7	Standard Yearling colt or filly	Standard yearling Colt or Filly. Class will be split if sufficient entries. 1st and 2nd eligible for Standard Junior Championship
8	Standard Two year old Colt or Filly	Standard two year old Colt or Filly. Colts must be bitted with the lead rein attached to the bit, are advised to wear a Stallion/Colt disc on the bridle, these are available from SPS-BS. Rosette for the best opposite sex to winner. 1st and 2nd eligible for Standard Junior Championship.
9	Standard Three year old Colt or Filly	Standard Three year old Colt or Filly. Colts must be bitted with the lead rein attached to the bit, are advised to wear a Stallion/Colt disc on the bridle, these are available from SPS-BS. Rosette for the best opposite sex to winner. 1st and 2nd eligible for Standard Junior Championship
10	Standard Intermediate.	Standard Intermediate To be 4 - 6 years old of age, any gender. Stallions must be bitted with the lead rein attached to the bit, are advised to wear a Stallion disc on the bridle, these are available from SPS-BS. Ponies may compete in any other applicable class. 1st and 2nd eligible for Standard Senior Championship
11	Standard Mare.	Four years and over, with or without foal at foot. Foals MUST be three weeks old and over. 1st and 2nd foals eligible for Foal Championship. 1st and 2nd Mares eligible for Standard Senior Championship
12	Standard Stallion	Standard Stallion. Four years old and over. Lead rein attached to the bit. Stallions are advised to wear a Stallion disk on their bridle. 1st and 2nd eligible for Standard Senior Championship.
13	Standard Broken Colour	Any age or gender. 1st and 2nd eligible for Broken Coloured Championship
14	Standard Solid Colour, including Black	Any age or gender. 1st & 2nd eligible for Solid Colour including Black Championship.

15	Miniature Novice Pony.	Miniature Novice Pony, any age and gender. Not to have been placed 1st up to entry closing date
16	Miniature Junior Gelding	Miniature Junior Gelding. Three years and under. Snelsmore Stud Rosette to 1st placed. 1st and 2nd eligible for Gelding Championship
17	Miniature Senior Gelding.	Miniature Senior Gelding. Four years old and over. Snelsmore Stud rosette to 1st placed. 1st and 2nd eligible for Gelding Championship.
18	Yearling Miniature Colt or Filly	Miniature yearling Colt or Filly. Class will be split if sufficient entries. GEMS Rosette to the highest placed GEMS member wearing a 2026 GEMS badge. 1st and 2nd eligible for Miniature Junior Championship
19	Two year old Miniature Colt or Filly	Miniature Two year old Colt or Filly Rosette for best opposite sex to winner. GEMS Rosette to the highest placed member wearing a 2026 GEMS badge. 1st and 2nd eligible for Miniature Junior Championship.
20	Miniature Three year old Colt or Filly	Miniature Three year old Colt or Filly Rosette for best opposite sex to winner. GEMS Rosette to the highest placed member wearing a 2026 GEMS badge. 1st and 2nd eligible for Miniature Junior Championship
21	Miniature Intermediate.	Miniature Intermediate. Four - six years old Any gender. Ponies may compete in any other applicable class. 1st and 2nd eligible for Miniature Senior Championship.
22	Miniature Mare	Miniature Mare. Four years and over. With or without foal at foot. Foals MUST be three weeks old and over. 1st and 2nd Foals eligible for Foal Championship. 1st and 2nd eligible for Miniature Senior Championship.
23	Miniature Stallion	Miniature Stallion. Four years old and over. Lead rein attached to the bit. Stallions are advised to wear a Stallion disk attached to the bridle. 1st and 2nd eligible for Miniature Senior Championship.
24	Owner Choice.	NEW CLASS. Two ponies owned by the same person. Need NOT be owner/exhibitor bred. Ponies may be any combination of the following: Miniature, Standard, any age, colt, filly, mare or gelding, broken colour, solid colour, black. Need not be related or a matched pair. NO STALLIONS
25	Miniature Broken Coloured	Miniature Broken Coloured. Any age or gender. 1st and 2nd eligible for the Broken Coloured Championship
26	Miniature Solid Colour including Black	Miniature Solid Colour including Black. Any age or gender. 1st and 2nd eligible for the Solid Colour including Black Championship
27	Veteran Miniature or Standard.	Veteran Miniature or Standard. Fifteen years old and over, any gender.
28	Exhibitor Bred.	Exhibitor bred Miniature or Standard. Any age or gender.
